Every child is different and responds to the programs differently. But many parents see improvement.

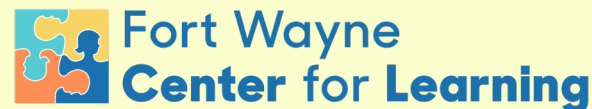
In the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year students increase percentile points an average of:

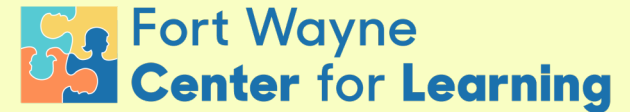

## Programs

### Intensive Instruction Programs:

In this program, trained instructors work one-on-one with your student using evidence-based programs that have been shown to be beneficial to students who struggle with reading, sounding out words, comprehension, math and computation.

Skills: Your student will learn Reading, Phonemic Awareness, Spelling, Reading and Listening Comprehension, Reading and Math Fluency, Mathematical Reasoning and Computation, Visual/Spatial Strategies, and Critical Thinking.

### Tutoring Program:

In this program, trained instructors work with your student on homework or specific concepts and theories.

Skills: Comprehension and application of skills related to the subjects.

## Programs Continued

### Academic Independence Management (AIM) Program:

In this program, trained instructors work with your student to support, coach, and facilitate the use of strategies and techniques to improve their focus, organization, and communication.

Skills: Study skills, note and test taking skills, homework completion, time management, and accountability.
